The Government of India, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has launched the **Global Housing Technology Challenge – India (GHTC-India)** on the 14th January, 2019 at New Delhi by Mr. Hardeep S Puri, the Hon'ble Minister of State (MoS) (Independent/Charge) for Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) in order to identify and mainstream a basket of innovative technologies from across the globe that are sustainable and disaster-resilient. Such technologies would be cost effective, speedier and ensure a higher quality of construction of houses, meeting diverse geo-climatic conditions and desired functional needs. The Challenge is in alignment with the transformative vision of the **Hon'ble Prime Minister of India** so as to rapidly deliver the low-cost housing in conformity with stringent environmental, societal, quality and economic standards.

2. The challenge has three main components as follows:

- i. Component 1 : Grand Expo-cum-Conference on Alternative and Innovative Construction Technologies**
- ii. Component 2 : Identifying and Mainstreaming Proven Demonstrable Technologies from around the world for the Construction of Lighthouse Projects (LHPs) in India**
- iii. Component 3 : Identifying Potential Future Technologies for Incubation and Acceleration Support through ASHA - India**

3. GHTC-India will encourage participation from across the affordable urban housing and construction sectors, such as technology providers, researchers, start-ups, developers, academia, public sector agencies, and civil society organizations etc. Such technologies is being invited to apply through GHTC-India website i.e. www.ghtc-india.gov.in.

As a sub-component, the Challenge will onboard selected State Governments/ Union Territories (UTs) through a competitive process to provide land for the construction of Lighthouse Projects (LHPs); and the register Indian Partners (Developers/ Construction Agencies) who may potentially support international players to demonstrate their technology through demonstrative Lighthouse Projects (LHPs) in India.
