Minutes of the 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of Project Monitoring Committee held on 02.03.2023 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary & Mission Director (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) to review the progress of Light House Projects (LHPs) under Global Housing Technology Challenge - India (GHTC-India)

12<sup>th</sup> meeting of Project Monitoring Committee was held on 02.03.2023 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary & Mission Director (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) in Room No. 120-G, Nirman Bhawan with the construction agencies of Light House Projects (LHPs) to review the progress of LHPs and consider release of the payments for the current running bills of the LHPs submitted by the Construction Agencies. The representative(s) of four LHP Construction Agencies, respective State Government officials, members of the PMC, officials of BMTPC and PMU members of HFA Division were present in the meeting physically or in online mode. The list of participants is enclosed at **Annexure**.

- 2. The Chairman welcomed the representatives of the LHP construction agencies and other participants to the PMC meeting and requested Director (HFA-V) to make a presentation on the progress of four LHPs i.e. LHP Indore, LHP Lucknow, LHP Ranchi and LHP Agartala. Highlights of the presentation are as follows:
- a. LHP Indore, Madhya Pradesh: The Committee noted with concern that commitment made by the construction agency and the technology provider to complete the Blocks No. 1, 2, 3 & 4 by 5th February 2023 was not achieved in spite of regular supply of panels. It was also noted that required progress in Block 5 and 6 to complete by end of February 2023 has not been made. The construction agency informed that since last PMC meeting, a total of 8,779 Sqm. wall panels were delivered at site and still around 13,000 Sqm. wall panels are required for completion of the project. The agency assured that the balance panels will be installed in next 30-35 days in case the supply is received in time. The construction agency informed that still permanent electricity connection upto project site is not yet provided by the State Govt. The representatives of Indore Municipal Corporation assured that electricity connection will be provided upto site timely.
- b. LHP Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh: It was observed that Block 1A and C is completed except lift installation. Superstructure of Block 4 has reached upto 13th floor level, finishing is in progress simultaneously. However, it was observed that the progress of the project is slow as per the schedule and commitment made in last PMC meeting. It was noted that in order to achieve the target committed to Chief Secretary, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh, installation of 5 units per day was required, however, only 3 units per day is being achieved. It was assured by the agency that except Tower1B and Tower 2, work of other towers will be completed with infrastructure by 15th March 2023 and complete the project in all respect by 30th April 2023. The Chairman directed the Construction Agency to put all its resources and increase the manpower further to complete the project without any further delay.
- c. **LHP Ranchi**, **Jharkhand**: It was observed that the superstructure work of Block 1 and 2 have been completed and finishing work like installation of uPVC, tiles, doors, MEP, painting etc. are in progress in all the floors. Superstructure work is in progress at 7<sup>th</sup> floor level in Block 6 & 7, at 4<sup>th</sup> floor in Block 5, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in Block 3 and third floor in Block 4. The agency has committed to complete Block

1 and 2 in all respect and superstructure of Block 6 & 7 by March 2023 end. Out of 1,008 DUs, till date 718 DUs have been erected. Although the pace of construction has increased in last two months, the Agency was advised to put more resources and speed up the work further so that the project could be completed before May 2023.

**d. LHP Agartala, Tripura:** It was observed that the superstructure work of Block 1 (A) & 7 (F) has reached upto 6<sup>th</sup> floor and in Block G, upto 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. The shear wall work of Block 5 (E) for lift well has reached upto 6<sup>th</sup> floor. It was noted that the current progress is still not upto the mark. In this regard, the Chairman advised that the agency should increase manpower and other resources to complete the project before start of rainy season.

# 3. Release of State and Beneficiary shares

The Committee noted the following status of release of State and Beneficiary share by respective State Government as informed by their Officials:

- i. **Jharkhand:** Out of Rs. 78.56 crore, only Rs. 9.04 crore has been received till date. Considering the current progress of project and high percentage of beneficiary share, it was advised that the State should release at least 50% of the State share and Beneficiary share at the earliest. In case of delay in receipt of share from beneficiaries, State may consider to release their share from its own resources so that progress of the project is not hampered.
- ii. **Madhya Pradesh:** As on date, State needs to release Rs. 19.44 crore which includes balance amount of Rs. 5.10 crore of second installment and third installment of Rs. 14.34 crore.

# 4. Release of Payment of pending bills of the agencies.

Director (HFA-V) apprised the PMC about the already payments made against the Running Bills submitted by the LHP Construction agencies and TPQMA agency. The Committee noted the details of the payments made till date for all the projects along with charges for TPQMA are as under:
