Minutes of 21st Meeting of Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) held on 21.05.2024 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary & Mission Director (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) to review the progress of Light House Projects (LHPs) under Global Housing Technology Challenge - India (GHTC-India)

21st meeting of Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) was held on 21.05.2024 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary & Mission Director (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) in Room No. 120-G, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi with the Construction Agencies of Light House Projects (LHPs) to review the progress of LHPs and consider release of the payments for the current Running Bills of the LHPs submitted by the Construction Agencies. The representative(s) of four LHP Construction Agencies, respective State Government officials, members of the PMC, officials of BMTPC and PMU members of HFA Division were present in the meeting physically or in online mode. The list of participants is enclosed at **Annexure**.

- 2. The Chairman welcomed the representatives of the LHP Construction Agencies and other participants to the PMC meeting and requested Deputy Director General (HFA-V) to make a presentation on the current progress of four LHPs i.e. LHP Lucknow, LHP Ranchi, LHP Indore and LHP Agartala. Following points emerged after the presentation:
- a. LHP Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh: The Committee noted that the project has been completed and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 10th March 2024 through video conferencing. State Government informed that they have allotted all the houses to the identified beneficiaries. The Chairman directed that the Construction Agency needs to ensure completion of balance minor works, if any to enable shifting of beneficiaries just after model code of conduct is over. The State Government was advised to expedite process of issuance of pending NOCs and complete the handover process by 10th June 2024.
- b. LHP Ranchi, Jharkhand: The project has been completed and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 10th March 2024. Construction Agency obtained all the required NOCs to allot these houses to the identified beneficiaries. Further, Construction Agency has informed that they have initiated the process of handing over of the project. The Chairman directed that State Government should ensure completion of external water supply line & drainage, and complete the handover process by 10th June 2024.
- c. LHP Indore, Madhya Pradesh: The project has been completed and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 5th October 2023. Construction Agency obtained all the required NOCs from concerned Department/Parastatal, and so far, 802 beneficiaries have shifted in their allotted houses. Further, Construction Agency has informed that they handed over the O&M services of STP, water supply, electrical services, lifts, community centre and Solid Waste Management Plant etc. The Chairman directed IMC to take over the project from Construction Agency along with BMTPC immediately. The Construction Agency was asked to ensure defects removal, if any during defect liability period.
- d. LHP Agartala, Tripura: The Committee noted with serious concern about the progress of LHP Agartala. The work at site is progressing at a dismissal speed. The official of State Government informed that no major work was done due to insufficient manpower, inadequate and untimely supply of materials and cash

flow issues. The Chairman emphasised that the Agency should increase manpower and other resources to complete the project at the earliest.

3. Release of State and Beneficiary shares

The Committee noted the following status of release of State and Beneficiary share by respective State Government as informed by their officials:

- i. **Jharkhand:** Out of ₹78.56 crore, ₹70.99 crore has been received till date. The project has been completed and inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. The State Government informed that they will be releasing approx. ₹4.00 crore to BMTPC escrow account.
- ii. **Tripura:** Out of ₹97.50 crore, only ₹56.47 crore has been received till date. Considering the current progress of project, the Chairman advised that the State should release the pending payment from its own resources at the earliest.

4. Release of Payment of pending bills of the Agencies

Deputy Director General (HFA-V) apprised the PMC about the payments already made against the Running Bills submitted by the LHP Construction Agencies and TPQMA Agency. The Committee noted the details of the payments made till date for all the projects along with charges for TPQMA as under:

5. Following Running Bills for payment received from LHP Construction Agencies have been examined by the BMTPC for release of payment. In view of some pending works and handing over formalities yet to be completed, the Committee decided to withhold an additional amount of ₹1.00 crore from the amount recommended by BMTPC for the LHPs at Ranchi and Indore.

After taking a considerate view on the current progress of the projects and the issues flagged by the Construction Agencies and respective States, the Chairman re-emphasized that Construction Agency of LHP Agartala must take necessary measures including regular and timely supply of materials and deployment of required additional manpower to complete the projects in all respect at the earliest. In case of other three projects, State Governments and Construction Agencies were advised to complete all formalities/NOCs for occupation of houses by the beneficiaries.
