Minutes of the 9th meeting of Project Monitoring Committee held on 06.12.2022 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary & Mission Director (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) to review the progress of Light House Projects (LHPs) under Global Housing Technology Challenge - India (GHTC-India)

9th meeting of Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) was held on 06.12.2022 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary & Mission Director (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) in Room No. 120-G, Nirman Bhawan with the Construction Agencies of Light House Projects (LHPs) to review the progress of LHPs and to consider release of the payments for the pending running bills of the LHP Construction Agencies. The representatives of five LHP Construction Agencies, respective State Government officials, members of the PMC, officials of BMTPC and PMU members of HFA Division were present in the meeting. The list of participants is enclosed at **Annexure**.

2. At the outset, Director (HFA-V) welcomed the Chairman, representatives of the LHP Construction Agencies and other participants to the PMC meeting. The Chairman in his opening remarks informed that the Construction Agencies must focus on Completion of LHPs projects at Indore, Lucknow, Ranchi and Agartala so that these are completed soon and handed over to beneficiaries as planned. The Chairman further emphasised that the Construction Agencies must take all measures to complete these projects in time.

Director (HFA-V) made a presentation on the progress of four LHPs i.e. LHP Indore, LHP Lucknow, LHP Ranchi and LHP Agartala. Highlights of the presentation are as follows:

- a. LHP Indore, Madhya Pradesh: The Superstructure work is in progress in all 8 Towers at various floors. In Tower 1, 2 & 3 finishing work is in progress. In Tower 4,5 and 6 PEB and slab work is completed, and EPS Wall panels are being installed at 8th, 7th and 6th floor respectively. In Tower 7 and 8, the Superstructure work is at advance stage. It was also observed that Infrastructure works like internal roads, Boundary wall and installation of solar panel is in progress. The agency informed that Block 1, 2, 3 & 4 will be completed and ready for handover by January 2023. The representative of State Government has informed that work at site is very slow and wall panels as per requirement to complete the project at the site are not available. The agency informed that the issue of supply of wall panels by the Technology Provider has still not been sorted out as per requirement. The Chairman directed the agency to resolve the issue of supply of the panels immediately so that the project may be completed without any further delay. It was directed that a separate meeting with the Technology Provider may also be conducted to resolve the logistic issues.
- b. **LHP Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh**: It was observed that Steel structural (PEB) erection and PVC Wallforms Installation work has been completed up to top storey i.e. 13th Floor in Block A1 (Part of Block A) & up to 13th Floor in other two Blocks C & D. In the remaining blocks i.e. Block B & Block A2, PEB work progress is quite slow. Out of total 1,040 DUs, only about 480 DUs have been completed till date with concreting of PVC Wallforms. The agency has assured that Block 1A will be completed by December 2022 and Block C & D by 20 January 2023. The Chairman expressed serious concern about the overall progress and directed the Agency to put all its resources and increase the manpower to complete the project without any further delay. Agency informed

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that they have initiated parallel activities on all building blocks, infrastructure works and assured to complete the project as per rescheduled time.

- c. **LHP Ranchi, Jharkhand**: It was observed that the Superstructure work of Block 1 and 2 have been completed upto 9th Floor and finishing work is in progress in 8th floor, at 2nd floor level in Block 5 & 6 and ground floor in Block 7. The Superstructure work of Block 3 & 4 has not yet started. Out of 1,008 DUs, till date 384 DUs have been erected. However, current pace of erection work was observed to be slow. The Agency stated that with installation of additional tower cranes in block 3 & 4, they plan to erect the components fast in the month of December 2022 and expedite the progress. Considering the assurance given by the Agency, the Chairman directed the Agency to speed up the pace of installation of DUs to complete the project by March 2023.
- d. **LHP Agartala, Tripura:** It was observed that the Superstructure work of Block F has reached upto 4th floor and in block A, 90 columns out of 94 columns have been erected. The Agency informed that Block A & F will be completed by February 2023 and Structure of G & B by February 2023. The work up to plinth is in progress in the Block No. B, C, E and G. A total of 110 piles have been completed out of 289 piles in Block D. The remaining 179 piles will be completed by December 2022. The average workforce at the site has increased since last 15 days and currently it is about 250 labours. The Chairman advised the Construction Agency to expedite the construction work by deploying more workforce at the site and by any means it should not go beyond May 2023 before rainy season starts. The Chairman also opined that the Agency should take advantage of the innovative technology and take all necessary measures to complete the work within the target date.

3. Release of State and Beneficiary shares

It was observed that the States of Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand have not yet released the matching State along with the beneficiary share due as on date. The Chairman requested the States to release the due share to BMTPC at the earliest. State Government representative of Madhya Pradesh informed that ₹10 crore have been transferred to Escrow account. It was also observed that State Government of Jharkhand has also transferred ₹2.26 crore to Escrow account. The Chairman suggested that the Beneficiary share should be collected before completion of the project otherwise, there may be defaulters at the time of possession.

4. Release of Payment of pending bills of the agencies

Director (HFA-V) apprised the PMC about the already payments made against the Running Bills submitted by the LHP Construction agencies and TPQMA agency. The details of the payments made till date for all the projects along with charges for TPOMA is as under:
