An overview of LHP Indore

After Light House Project (LHP) Chennai and Rajkot, Indore is the next in line to be inaugurated. Comprising of 1,024 dwelling units at a prime location in the city, LHP Indore has been built using Prefabricated Sandwich Panel System with Pre-engineered Steel Structural System technology, an already established system for building construction in Australia, Japan, African and Gulf countries. It replaces conventional brick and mortar walling construction practices. Fast tracking of construction process, resource efficiency, drastic reduction of water consumption are some of the special features of the technology.

Constructed at a cost of ₹ 128 crore, the total built up area of LHP Indore is 45,631.97 sqm. The project is spread in 8 towers in a S+8 floor setting. All modern and basic infrastructure such as community centre, solid waste management plant, water supply, drainage, sewerage system, rain water harvesting, STP, internal roads, lifts, solar lighting, etc., are equipped here. The beneficiaries have already been identified for this project.

JS&MD, HFA chairs Project Monitoring Committee meeting to review progress of Light House Projects

On 21st July 2023, a meeting to review progress of LHPs at Indore (Madhya Pradesh), Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh), Ranchi(Jharkhand)and Agartala(Tripura) was chaired by Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (JS&MD), Housing For All (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). This was the 16th meeting of the Project Monitoring Committee (PMC), constituted to evaluate progress of LHPs.

Shri RK Gautam, Director, HFA, senior officials of the Ministry, officials from the various State Governments, officials of BMTPC, officials associated with the LHP construction agencies and other concerned stakeholders also attended the meeting.

During the meeting, JS&MD, HFA was apprised about the progress at each LHP site through a presentation, along with photos and highlights, summing up the work done so far. Chennai, Rajkot, Indore, Lucknow, Ranchi and Agartala are the six cities hosting the LHPs. The projects in Chennai and Rajkot were completed in



2022 and inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister. LHP Indore is the final stage of completion, whereas LHP Lucknow and LHP Ranchi are in advanced stages of completion while Agartala is under construction.

After taking a considerate view on the progress of projects, JS&MD, HFA emphasised that necessary steps must be taken to ensure regular and timely supply of materials and deployment of additional manpower to complete the four LHP projects in all respect within the stipulated time frame.

State-wise review of LHPs is as follows:



LHP Indore: Superstructure work and finishing work have been completed at the site while lift installation is inprogress.

LHP Lucknow: Finishing work is completed in Towers A1, C & D and lift installation work is currently being done. The superstructure work has reached the advanced stage in Towers A2 & B and finishing work is in progress simultaneously.

LHP Agartala: Superstructure work, including LGSF, is currently under progress in Towers A & F. The shear wall work and left well is also ongoing in Towers B, C, E & G. JS&MD directed the agency to increase manpower and other resources on site to complete work at a fast pace.


